#### **SESSION HIGHLIGHTS**

The sixteen Elders on our Session were elected by the congregation to serve, along with the Pastor, as leaders for the Church. Elders on Session serve to strengthen and nurture the faith and life of the church.

Session met for a stated meeting on Wednesday, April 26. Pastor John Lentz was the Moderator. After opening with prayer, we addressed many issues, including:

- Had a spiritual conversation to discern ways in which we do or do not carry out the work of Session in accordance with the Traits of the Beloved Community.
- · Approved the transfer of membership of Dara Elliott, at her request.
- Approved the celebration of the Lord's Supper planned for Sunday, May 21.
- Reviewed the financial report. Reviewed and approved a revised description of the Committee on Finance. This committee will now focus on budgeting with attention to midand long-term issues and recommendations.
- Learned about the ongoing work of the Creating Racial Equity Committee. This
  committee is serving to enable improvement in measures of racial equity as
  recommended by the Racial Equity Survey. They are supporting ministries and auditing
  how the church works to meet racial equity goals.
- Discussed and approved a Minority Vendor Purchasing Policy that will seek to increase our engagement with minority-owned businesses.
- Discussed the need for the church to consider the nature of our pastoral leadership model, our mission and our engagement with the community. We will seek to work with an external third-party to help us better understand the thoughts of leadership and congregants.

# 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Homeless Stand Down

On Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 16 FHC members and friends joined over 300 other volunteers at the 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Homeless Stand Down, Cleveland Public Auditorium. With its long history of participation, FHC was a supporting sponsor of the event this year. Despite the rainy

weather, 800 people experiencing homelessness received "resources, respite, and reconnection." FHC volunteers served as personal shoppers for our guests, helping them select backpacks, clothing, hygiene kits, and books as well as Subway gift cards and 24-hour bus passes. Each guest also received a hot meal and a bagged lunch and were invited to access everything from haircuts to health care to housing assistance. It was a truly moving and uplifting experience for all participants.





Many, many thanks to everyone, staff and members of FHC, for helping to make our Gun Surrender Event a success. While I would have been happy if we had been able to melt down more guns, knowing that we were able to make certain the ones we received will <u>never</u> hurt anyone is a huge relief.

Pastor Lentz was a stalwart champion from the beginning. Derry Stauffer, Jack and Mary Ann Breisch and Gary Lustic served faithfully on the Planning Committee and volunteered the day of the event. Those were just the folks from the church.
